<p>Pick (someone) up "I'll pick you up at the station at 6 in the morning.</p>	<p>To get someone from a place</p>
<p>See (someone) off My sister came to see me off.</p>	<p>To go to the airport, train station, or bus station with someone and say goodbye</p>
<p>Hop on/off With a one-day ticket you can hop on and off as you like.</p>	<p>Get on or off a bus, train etc.</p>
<p>Stay on The hotel was so nice we decided to stay on for a few days.</p>	<p>To stay longer than intended.</p>
<p>Get away I hope to get away for a few days soon.</p>	<p>To escape (e.g. from work) for a break or holiday.</p>
<p>Stop over I wanted to stop over in India on the way to Australia</p>	<p>To stay somewhere for a short time during a long journey</p>
<p>Hold up Sorry I'm late – I was held up at work.</p>	<p>To be delayed when travelling</p>
<p>Check in I checked in to the hotel when I arrived.</p>	<p>To arrive and register at a hotel or airport</p>
<p>Check out When I checked out I gave them back the key.</p>	<p>To pay the bills and give back the key before leaving the hotel</p>
