# Prediction with little evidence level 2 A2

- I think it **will rain** tomorrow.
- I think he **will fail** his test.
- He **won't be** home by 10.



# On the spot/ spontaneous decision level 2 A2

- A: What would you like to drink?  
B: **I'll have** an orange juice
- A: Would you like to come to the party?  
B: Yea, why not. **I'll come.**

# Promises

## level 2 A2

- **I'll clean** my room, I promise.
- **I'll do** it later, don't worry.
- **I'll finish** the report by the end of the day.



# Willingness / refusal

## level 2 A2

- I'll **make** dinner for you.
- I'll **pick** up the phone.
- We can't go, the car **won't start**.
- She **won't come**. I have asked her before.

# A request level 3 B1

- **Will you please answer the phone?**
- **Will you close the door please?**
- **Won't you come to the party?**



# A threat/ warning level 3 B1

- If you don't clean your room, **I'll take** away your phone.
- Watch out, **you'll break** it!

# 1 conditional

## level 2 A2

- **I'll come over** when I finish cooking.
- **I'll tell** him if I don't forget.
- if it doesn't rain, **we'll go** to the park.



# Future time clauses

## level 3 B1

- **I'll be** there as soon as I finish.
- **I won't** move until I find a job.
- **I'll clean** everything before I go to bed.
- **I'll write** the report after I'm done with this.
- The moment I see him, **I'll tell** him.
