When do you use it again?

At a specific moment in the future B1

- We'll be having diner at <u>6</u>.
- I'll be watching a movie at 9.
- I'll be cooking when you get home.
- He'll be waiting for you when your flight arrives.

Action happening now expected to continue B2

- We'll still be cleaning in an hour.
- We'll be working on this <u>for</u> the next few days.

Predicting the present B1

- Don't call her, she'll be sleeping.
- He'll probably be working right now.

To give a reminder/warning B2

- Hurry up, the train will be leaving soon.
- The meeting will be starting any minute now, so come and join us.

For future intentions C1

- I will be helping my sister this weekend.
- I'll be travelling to Prague next week.

Habbits in the future C1

- We'll be visiting my parents in Spain, <u>like every year</u>.
- <u>Like every Sunday</u>, he'll be playing football.
- For the next few weeks I'll be working weekends.

To ask polite questions C1

- Will you be leaving soon?
- Will you be needing any assistance?
- Will you be joining us later?
