### Past Perfect

#### For the past

An action before another action in the past A2

- When we <u>arrived</u> the concert had already started.
- I <u>remembered</u> I hadn't forgotten to lock the door.
  Had you finished painting when the rain <u>started</u>?

### A past life experience upto a moment in time B1

- I'd lived on 4 different continents by the time I was 40.
- I hadn't been to Egypt <u>until I met</u> <u>my wife</u>.
- Had you eaten crocodile <u>before</u> you went to Vietnam?

### How long till a certain moment in time B1

- When I left the company, I'd worked there for 6 years.
- They hadn't even known each other for 10 days before they got married.
- Had you lived there for more than a year before you left?

# Action in the past with past result (cause & effect) B1

- I arrived late, <u>because</u> I had missed my bus.
- I managed to leave on time because I hadn't forgotten to set my alarm.

#### 3rd conditional unreal things in the past B1

- If I had studied more, I would have passed my exam.
- If I hadn't been late, I wouldn't have been fired.
- Had you known, would you still have done it?

#### Mixed conditional unreal things in the past with present result C1+

- If I had studied more, I would probably be a doctor now.
- If I hadn't gone to bed so late,
   I wouldn't be so tired now.
- If you had done some more sport, would you be healthier?

#### Mixed conditional unreal things in the past with future result C1+

- If I had finished all my reports I wouldn't have to do them over the weekend.
- If I hadn't broken my leg, I would be going skiing tomorrow.
- <u>Would you still be cleaning up</u>, if you hadn't got some help from your friends?
