Present Perfect

*When do you use it
again?*

A past experience upto now / Life experience A1

- **I have never been** to Egypt.
- **I've lived** on 4 different continents.
- **I haven't seen** the movie yet.
- **I have swum** with sharks.
- **Have you ever ridden** a motorbike?

Something started in the past and still continues A2

- I **have been** married for 8
years.
- I **have lived** here since 2015.
- I **have known** him for 15
years.

Recent completed actions A2

- I've just **finished** cleaning my room.
- I've already **done** my homework.
- I've just **sent** you the email.

Action in the past with present result

B1

- I can't find my keys. I've just **lost** them.
- He's **had** an accident, so he can't come to work.
- She's **missed** the bus and will be late.

Multiple actions over time B1

- I've seen here 3 times this morning.
- We've met several times.

Change over time

C1

- *She's **grown** a lot over the last few years.*
- *Grammar **has become** more and more difficult.*

1 conditional and future time clauses focused on completion

C1

- When I've finished my homework, I'll go out for some drinks.
- I'll come after I've watched the news.
- I'll be there as soon as I've packed my bag.
