Present Simple

For the present

Something that is always true A1

- Water boils at a 100°C.
- Ice is cold.

Something that's seen as always true B1

- It <u>always</u> **rains** when I wash my car.
- She is never on time.

Routines/Habits A1

- I go to the gym twice a week.
- Every morning I wake up at 6.
- She visits her mother <u>once a</u> month.
- They sometimes watch a movie.

Permanent situations A1

- He is a doctor.
- They **live** in London.
- I have a sister.

o conditional A2

- If you want to come, call me before 6.
- When you eat too much, you get fat.
- When I do yoga, I feel relaxed.

Present Simple

For the future

Future time tabled events B2

- The bus **leaves** at 8.
- I have an appointment on Monday.
- Her class starts next week.
- The meeting **finishes** at 5.30.

1 conditional A2

- When I pass my exam, I'll celebrate.
- If it rains, we'll stay home.
- If I see Jack, I'll tell him.

Future time clauses B1

- After I finish cleaning, I'll help you.
- I'll come over <u>as soon as</u> I'm done.
- I'll finish my report <u>before</u> I **go** home.
- I won't leave until I finish.
