Form: Active vs Passive

Active He builds houses Subject + verb + object The subject is doing the action: He is doing the building

Passive Object becomes the subject Houses are built (by him) The subject is NOT doing the action: The house does not built itself

Form

Houses are built (by him) Subject + verb to be (in different forms) + Past Participle + (object)

Form

- Present simple
 - They make TVs in China: TVs are made in China
- Present continuous
 - They are checking his work: His work is being checked
- Present perfect
 - Someone has broken into my house: My house has been broken into

Form

- Simple past
 - Someone stole my wallet: My wallet was stolen
- Will
 - Someone will help you: You will be helped
- Modals
 - He can't do it now. It <u>can't be</u> done now



Form

- -ing form
 - I don't like people shouting at me: I <u>don't like being</u> shouted at.
- To + inf form
 - You need to give feedback: Feedback needs to be given,
- By
 - \circ $\,$ Can be added if we do want to stress who is doing the action $\,$
 - Feedback needs to be given by your manager

Meaning/ usage: When we don't know who did it

My car <u>was stolen</u>. We don't know who stole the car.

Meaning/ usage: When it is obvious

When it is obvious He <u>has been arrested</u> on suspicion of burglary It is obvious: the police

Meaning/ usage: Not important who does it

Not important who does it Many products <u>are made</u> in China Who cares? Probably some people in some factory somewhere.

Meaning/ usage: In news broadcasts or articles

In news broadcasts or articles No survivors <u>have been found</u>

Meaning/ usage: In academic writing

In academic writing The theory <u>was first proposed</u> in the 19th century.

Meaning/ usage: To avoid responsibility

To avoid responsibility Errors <u>were made</u> and <u>will be dealt with</u>

Meaning/ usage: With reporting verbs

- It is said: It is said that the data may have been manipulated.
- It is believed: It <u>is believed</u> that the origins of this tradition dates back to ancient times.
- It has been reported: It has been reported that the new law will have a significant impact.
- It is thought: It is thought that the effects of the policy will be far-reaching.
- It is understood: It is understood that a consensus has been reached.
- It is rumoured: It <u>is rumoured</u> there will be changes in the company's leadership.
- It is known: It <u>is widely known</u> that the climate is changing rapidly.

Challenging

The challenging part for the students is:

- Selecting the correct tense (present simple, past continuous,...) <u>Not</u> really making the passive voice
- When to use passive voice or active voice
 - \circ $\,$ Students mix them up sometimes $\,$
